INFORMATION YOU SHOULD KNOW

- **VETERAN DISABILITY BENEFITS ARE BROKEN INTO TWO BASIC PROGRAMS:** Service Connected (SC) Disability and Non-Service Connected Pension (NSC).
- **WIDOWS OF VETERANS ALSO HAVE TWO BASIC PROGRAMS:** Dependent Indemnity Compensation (DIC) and Death Pension.
- **THE INITIAL VA APPLICATION PROCESS TAKES APPROXIMATELY 3-6 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.**
- **SERVICE CONNECTED BENEFITS ARE BASED ON ILLNESSES AND INJURIES INCURRED DURING OR MADE WORSE IN SERVICE.** The pension program is based on the Veteran's income/illness.
- **THE VA PROVIDES "PRESUMPTIVE" DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR SEVERAL CONDITIONS** for individuals who served in Vietnam, Gulf War, and Iraq.
- **VETERANS CURRENTLY SERVICE CONNECTED AT 60-70% AND WHO ARE NO LONGER ABLE TO WORK MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A PROGRAM CALLED INDIVIDUAL UNEMPLOYABILITY (IU).** This can increase the Veteran's service connection pay to 100% based on their inability to work.
