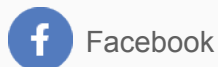

With the Direct Express® card program, Social Security deposits your federal payment directly into your card account. Your monthly funds will be available on your payment day — on time, every time. You can use the card to make purchases, pay bills or get cash at thousands of locations. And most transactions are free.

The Direct Express® card is both safer and more convenient than paper checks. Anyone receiving Social Security or Supplemental Security Income payments can enroll even if they don't have a bank

Direct deposit automatically deposits your benefits payment into your checking account. It is a simple, safe and secure way to get your benefits. If you would like Social Security to send your payment to a bank or credit union account, have the following information ready when you apply:

- Your financial institution's routing transit number;
- Account type (checking or savings); and
- Account number.

Signing up is simple—you can contact your bank to help you sign up for direct deposit, or sign up through Social Security.

No matter which method you choose—Direct Deposit or Direct Express® card—receiving your payments electronically is safer, easier, and more convenient. You won't have to wait for the mail to arrive, there's no risk of a lost or stolen check, and you won't have to make a trip to cash or deposit a check.
